## Recommendation:

That the Executive Director is authorized to enter into a Project Scope and Budget Agreement and a Project Funding Agreement with the Town of Braintree for the repair of the existing Braintree South Middle School.

## Background:

The District submitted nine Statements of Interest (SOI) on March 23, 2007. Braintree South Middle School, the district's priority, is a 72,041 gross square foot, 1956 facility, housing grades 6-8. The total enrollment at the Braintree South Middle School for the 2007-2008 school year was 523 students.

The District identified several building deficiencies, including rusting, single-pane, exterior windows, aging HVAC systems including pneumatic controls and unit ventilators and inadequate electrical systems. At its meeting on August 8, 2008, the MSBA Board of Directors voted to move the Braintree South Middle School from the Hold category to the Repair Assessment category to assess the possibility of repairing HVAC, electrical and window systems at the facility.

## Project Description

MSBA staff has reviewed the drawings and specifications provided by the District. The District has provided a project budget of **\$3,053,701** which includes a construction cost of **\$2,420,090**.
