## Discussion

MSBA staff reviewed the consultants' existing conditions analysis and the proposed schedule provided by the District and have met with the District and its consultants to discuss the scope and budget. This scope of work included the replacement of the windows and exterior finishes at the Wampatuck Elementary School and the replacement of exterior finishes, exterior doors, and select roof sections at the Gates Intermediate School. The proposed scope of work to be completed at the Wampatuck Elementary School includes the replacement of the window walls including exterior doors, skylights (3), boilers, hot water heater, HVAC system, electrical panels, emergency generator, and select tile flooring. The District has provided a total project budget of \$4,888,341, which includes an estimated final construction cost of \$3,852,926. The basis of the Total Facilities Grant would be \$4,888,341. The project budget by school breakdown is shown in the table below:
