## Discussion

MSBA staff has reviewed the schematic drawings, specifications, and cost estimates provided by the District and has met with the District and its consultants to discuss scope and budget. The District has provided a total project budget of \$28,696,907 which includes an estimated construction cost of \$21,731,066. The basis of the Total Facilities Grant would be \$25,998,657, which excludes site costs in excess of 8% of the building construction costs and ineligible costs associated with abatement of asbestos-containing floor materials, mailing and moving costs, and swing space.

The District is proposing three additional classrooms in the ground floor as an alternate with an estimated budget of \$223,099. As the District does not intend to pursue this alternate unless it can be done within the existing budget, the estimated cost for this alternate is not included in either the Total Project Budget or the Estimated Basis of Total Facilities Grant. All costs associated with the proposed alternate are categorically ineligible for reimbursement by the MSBA and would be 100% borne by the District.
