## **Discussion**

MSBA staff reviewed the documents provided by the District and met with the District and its consultants to discuss scope and budget. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$28,183,801, which includes an estimated construction cost of \$21,563,821 (\$340/sf). The basis of the estimated maximum Total Facilities Grant would be \$22,131,143, which excludes OPM fees in excess of 3.5% of construction costs, ineligible costs associated with abatement of asbestos-containing floor materials, site costs in excess of 8% of total building cost, costs associated with mailing and moving, furnishings and equipment cost above the \$2,400 per student, construction costs in excess of \$275 per square foot, and owner's and construction contingency costs.

The District also is proposing three alternates totaling \$524,695, which the District will pursue only if they can be done within the existing construction budget. Therefore, the estimated cost for these alternates is not included in either the Total Project Budget or the basis for the estimated maximum Total Facilities Grant. The MSBA will not participate in any costs associated with the three alternates. All costs associated with these alternates are ineligible for reimbursement and would be 100% borne by the District.

MSBA staff recommends an estimated maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$13,874,014; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$1,420,086 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$15,294,099 for the Project Scope and Budget Agreement and Project Funding Agreement for the replacement of the Plains Elementary School with a new elementary school facility on the existing site.
