Discussion

The OPM and Designer conducted a feasibility analysis of the facility and developed a schematic design including a proposed scope of work, schedule, and estimated budget. The District's Designer, CGKV Architects, Inc., recommends a partial roof replacement project at the Hastings Middle School. The Designer has confirmed that the roof will be in compliance with the MSBA's sustainability requirements.

MSBA staff reviewed the consultants' existing conditions analysis and proposed schedule provided by the District and have discussed the scope and budget with the District and its consultants. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$870,282, which includes a construction cost of \$633,861. Construction costs include:

- \$448,535 (\$20.39/sq. ft.) for the polyvinyl chloride ("PVC") roof
- \$185,326 for demolition and other associated roof work

MSBA staff recommends an Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$439,701; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$19,101 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, MSBA staff recommends a Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$458,802 for the Project Funding Agreement for a partial roof replacement project at the Hastings Middle School.

² Scope exclusions/ineligible costs include construction contingency in excess of the 5% construction budget cap and owner's contingency in excess of the 0.5% construction budget cap.

³ The "Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant" is calculated by applying the reimbursement rate to the "Estimated Basis of Total Facilities Grant." It does not include any grant funds for potentially eligible owner's or construction contingency expenditures and is subject to MSBA review and audit.

⁴ Includes eligible and ineligible owner's and construction contingency.

⁵ The "Potential additional grant funds for eligible owner's and construction contingency expenditures" is calculated by applying the reimbursement rate to the "Potentially eligible owner's and construction contingencies."

⁶ Includes maximum possible owner's and construction contingency grant funds, the final amount of which, if any, shall be determined by the MSBA keeping with its policies for the determination of eligibility. The MSBA does not anticipate that the District will expend all of its contingency funds on expenses that are eligible for MSBA reimbursement.
