The MSBA has provisionally included one (1) incentive point for the Construction Manager at Risk construction delivery method, subject to the District receiving approval from the Office of the Inspector General to utilize this method. The MSBA also has provisionally included two (2) incentive points for energy efficiency, subject to the District meeting certain sustainability requirements for the project. If the District does not receive approval for the Construction Manager at Risk delivery method and/or does not meet the requirements for the energy efficiency, the District will not qualify for these incentive points, respectively, and the MSBA will adjust the reimbursement rate accordingly.

Discussion

MSBA staff reviewed the documents provided by the District and met with the District and its consultants to discuss the scope and budget. The District has provided a Total Project Budget of \$83,472,211, which includes an estimated construction cost of \$67,736,699 (\$367/sq. ft.). The Estimated Basis of Total Facilities Grant would be \$69,371,501, which excludes: legal fees; costs associated with the auditorium renovation; costs associated with gymnasium square footage exceeding 12,000 nsf; costs associated with stage square footage exceeding 1,600 nsf; costs associated with abatement of asbestos-containing floor materials; construction costs in excess of \$312/sq. ft.; costs associated with mailing and moving; and owner's and construction contingency costs.

Additionally, the MSBA will recover a portion of the commissioning consultant fees associated with ineligible square footage noted above in the auditorium, gymnasium, and stage. The MSBA has calculated this recovery to be \$7,160 and this amount has been deducted from the Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant and the Maximum Total Facilities Grant.

MSBA staff recommends an Estimated Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$40,214,436; however, the District may be eligible for up to an additional \$1,072,432 in grant funds, subject to the MSBA's review and audit of the District's owner's and construction contingency expenditures. Accordingly, staff recommends a Maximum Total Facilities Grant of \$41,286,868 for the Project Scope and Budget Agreement and Project Funding Agreement for an addition and renovation project to the East Middle School.

² Does not include any grant funds for potentially eligible owner's or construction contingency expenditures; subject to MSBA review and audit.

³ Includes maximum possible owner's and construction contingency grant funds, the final amount of which, if any, shall be determined by the MSBA in its sole discretion. The MSBA does not anticipate that the District will expend all of its contingency funds on expenses that are eligible for MSBA reimbursement.
