Student Guided Self-Tour

Welcome to Mountain View School! We are excited for our students to show you around. Try not to miss any of the highlights of our beautiful school. Recycled products are used throughout the building.

Main Lobby and Administrative Offices

- This is where students and visitors enter the building. Our administrative assistants are there to greet you when you come to Mountain View during the day. Notice the Terrazzo flooring throughout the first floor hallways. This material is long lasting and durable. You will notice a card reader system at each entrance. Mountain View has a state-of-the-art camera system for both the inside and exterior of the building.

Cafeterias

- Our elementary and middle school cafeterias feature a full-service kitchen that serves lunch to the entire school. When the weather is nice, there is an outdoor patio for elementary and middle school students to eat.

Health Office

- A large nurses' area with separate entrances and waiting areas for elementary and middle school students.

Instructional Wings

- Check out your child's classroom and meet the teacher.
- Each classroom has large windows to allow for natural light, ample storage space, thoughtfully designed fixtures and furniture, writable and magnetic wall spaces, and a sink.

- Students in Grades K-5 have in class storage cubbies and hooks. Students in Grades 6-8 have lockers in the hallways.
- There are break-out, small group spaces shared between two classrooms that allow for small group work and project-based learning activities.
- Look up and check out the interesting lighting choices, which can be dimmed.
- Large screen TV screens that connect wirelessly to teacher and student computers for active learning and project sharing.
- Multiple and single occupancy restrooms are located on each floor. There is a lactation space on floors one and two for members of our school community to use.
- Middle School grades each have science classrooms on each floor including laboratory tables, a demonstration podium with safety equipment such as a chemical hood for experiments.
- Maker spaces with a garage-like door are housed in the middle school wing.
- Literacy closets on each floor hold classroom library books.

Library Media Centers

- Each library media center (2nd floor elementary, 3rd floor middle) contains updated books, databases and ample areas to work and learn. Notice the metal sunshades from the backside. Do you know what that image is? These are illuminated by LED lights at night.
- Check out the varied seating options.

Gymnasium

- This space serves as a physical education space and as a performance space. There is a dividing wall that can split the gym in two. There is also a dividing curtain creating three physical education spaces.
- We can seat 700 people on the bleachers and more on the floor. Our whole school community fits here.
- The stage area opens to a theater size performance area with professional quality stage lighting.
- There is an adaptive PE space prioritized for adaptive PE. It may also be used for yoga or rock climbing (see the climbing wall and ropes

course). Notice the flooring is specifically designed for these activities. There is also a stage for smaller performances in this space.

Art Rooms (2nd floor elementary, 1st floor middle)

- These spaces were designed with creativity in mind. There are large tables, storage and drying areas, and a kiln. The floors are made of concrete for easy clean up.

Music Rooms and Band Room

- Elementary music is outside the elementary cafeteria. Students visit once a week.
- Follow the hallway on the left past the gymnasium to find the band room and middle school music rooms. Notice the instrument storage, sound proof panels, and separate areas for practice rooms.

Outdoor Play Areas

- There is ample green space for children to run and play.
- Grades 5-8 use the upper playground play structures and basketball courts.
- There are three different play areas behind the school with one of them designated for just PK and kindergarten.
- Check out the natural playground equipment, in-ground slides, the pergola, and amphitheater. Outdoor learning is encouraged.
- There is a garden space to the right of the PK/K playground. This area houses several raised garden beds.
